(Apologies from Janet Eagle Smith and Simon Wilmot)</p> <p>Club Captain is to produce names of members within the club with a coaching qualification or experience.</p> <p>The Chair would in due course produce relevant TORs, in line with England Hockey and Club First accreditation.</p>
<p>Coaching Team and Head Coach</p> <p>A Coaching Team is to be formed, Mr Chris Brady will be officially offered the position of Head Coach and the EC has agreed to support his travelling expenses as a form of payment.</p> <p>Mr Club Captain and the level 1 coaches from within the club would be asked to support the coaching team. The Head coach will determine the coaching requirements of all the teams but will focus on the Clubs first teams.</p> <p>All mandated courses would be supported by the club, the individual/coach/umpire would be asked to initially support the financial cost with a reimbursement procedure to put in place dependant on the return to the club.</p>	<p>Chairperson, is to official offer the position to Mr Brady</p> <p>Club Captain to take a lead</p> <p>Simon Wilmot, Nicky Buckby, Chris Brady would be asked to engage with the Safeguarding and Protecting Children course. First Aid certification would be recommended for all coaches and team captains. Nicky Buckby would look into First Aid course.</p>
<p>Treasurer Report</p> <p>The Treasurer reported that the club was health however, the EC decided that unpaid subs would have to be written off if no evidence of payment could be found.</p> <p>The Treasury asked if Captains and the Club Captain could make sure at the beginning of the season to produce a comprehensive list of players and thus she would offer advice on payment methods.</p> <p><i>The Treasurer suggested a new concept of paying 09/10 subs, the members of the club would be encourage to take out a standing order beginning in June 09 paying a £10 or £20 order therefore easing the financial strain especially during the session with the costs of playing fees as well as the subs.</i></p>	<p>Captains & Club Captain.</p> <p><i>Club Captains are to promulgate this information as a priority.</i></p>
<p>Dave Hull Tournament</p> <p>The Social member is organising the event, it will take place on 27th June 09. MDHC relationship with Deeping Leisure remains on a positive stance and as such the Mgr has agreed to give the Astro free of charge for the day.</p>	<p>The Social Member would write an article for the website ensuring that the generosity of the leisure centre would be mentioned.</p>
