<p>Dave Hull Tournament</p> <p>The Social member informed the committee that the event was on track and would it will take place on 27<sup>th</sup> June 09. Deeping Leisure Centre has agreed to give the pitch free of charge to allow more profits to go to both Macmillan cancer support and the NSPCC.</p> <p>The Chair point out that a Captains brief at the beginning of the tournament would elevate any forth-coming problems.</p> <p>The main POC's for the event are: Kirsten, Kindy and Sarah.</p>	<p>Post the event the Social Member would write an article for the website ensuring that the generosity of the leisure centre would be mentioned.</p>
<p>Treasurer Report</p> <p>The Treasurer reported that the club was healthy with a balance of approx £3,400 in the account.</p> <p>The Treasurer asked if the Captains and the Club Captain could make sure that at the beginning of the season they would produce a comprehensive list of players.</p> <p><i>The Treasurer suggested a new concept of paying 09/10 subs, the members of the club would be encourage to take out a standing order beginning in June 09 paying a £10 or £20 order therefore easing the financial strain especially during the session with the costs of playing fees as well as the subs.</i></p> <p>The treasurer highlighted that a more effective method of booking the function room for committee meetings would be through the Fixture Secretary with DLC invoicing directly to the Treasurer.</p>	<p>Captains &amp; Club Captain.</p> <p>Kev Baker highlighted that a more effect method of disseminating information was through the web and a global email to all members, Simon Wilmot will engage with the Web Master to discuss this possibility.</p> <p>The Committee agreed with this in principle and the Fixture Secretary would be advised accordingly.</p>
<p>Business Strategy and Sponsorship</p> <p>The Business Mgr informed the committee that direction was required if there was to be a successful sponsorship campaign. A short, medium and long term strategy was to be developed.</p> <p>Club First accreditation was paramount if sponsorship was to become a realistic achievement, Kev pointed out that such an achievement would only promote</p>

<p><b>Club Day</b></p> <p>Richard Wood is organising a Club Day (4<sup>th</sup> July 09), it is open to all members and any one in the community that wants to take up hockey, a BBQ would be available on the day with soft drinks.</p> <p>Steve Windsor has put together a Press Release for the event to raise the profile of the club.</p>	<p>Richard, to give a Post event summary at the next meeting</p>
